

DUES DEDUCTION AUTHORIZATION



I hereby authorize and direct CCSNH to deduct from my pay an amount equal to the dues and amounts fixed in accordance with the Constitution of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers and to pay same to said Local Union in accordance with the terms of the bargaining agreement, and/ or affiliation agreement, between IBEW Local 2320 and CCSNH.

This authorization is voluntarily made in order to pay my fair share of the Union's cost of representing me for the purposes of collective bargaining, and this authorization is not conditioned on my present or future membership in the Union.

This authorization shall be irrevocable for a period of one year from the date hereof or until the termination date of said agreement, whichever occurs sooner, without regard to whether I am a member of the Union during that period, and I agree that this authorization shall be automatically renewed and irrevocable for successive periods of one year unless revoked by written notice to you and the Union within the fifteen day period commencing with the employees anniversary date of employment. I understand that under current law the payments covered by this authorization are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.
